- All 74 banners sold, with 51 getting 10 or more bid forcing them to the live auction, this is the first time all banners have been sold the night of the auction
- Banners were produced by 37 artists
- 54 different buyers made banner purchases on Saturday night.
- Jennifer Heyd Wharton was the top selling artist for 2007
- Four banners were sold in the silent auction for the starting bid of \$75
- The first \$75 of the sales price goes to purchase canvases for 2008's Arts in Easton Banner Auction, the remaining balance is split 75% to the artist and 25% going to Easton Main Street which through its partnership with the Avalon Foundation promotes the Arts in Easton on a year round basis.
- The Banner Auction was produced by Easton Main Street in partnership with the Avalon Foundation and made possible by support from the Talbot County Arts Council, a great team of volunteers and by our host venue, the Academy Art Museum.
- Additions to the Banner project this year included a walking tour of banners and bios of each artist located on the lampposts.
